Which One?

Which introduces a question of either importance or not important. So, which is important to you?

1. There are two ways to begin each day: with prayer or without prayer. Which one do you begin your day? (Psa. 55:17; 1 Tim. 5:5).
2. There are two ways of spending the Lord's Day: idly or devotionally. Which way do you spend it? (Heb. 10:25; Acts 20:7).
3. There are two classes of people in the world: the saved and the lost. To which class do you belong? (Mk. 16:16; Acts 2:47; Lk. 13:23-29).
4. There are two masters: God and Satan. You are serving one of these two, but which one? (Matt. 6:24; Jn. 6:44).
5. There are two kingdoms in the world: the kingdom of darkness (Satan-Matt. 12:26) and the kingdom of Christ. To

which one do you belong? (Col. 1:12-14; Jn. 3:3-5).
